TERMS AND CONDITIONS

All bookings [reservations] are subject to availability and a satisfactory number of participants in attendance. Should the need arise to cancel any course, i.e. due to an insufficient number of applicants, an alternative, if available, will be offered or a full refund will be given.

In returning the booking form you agree to pay a deposit fee to reserve your space and the full course cost no later than the following dates: if your program begins in July 2008, all balances are due May 1, 2008. If your program begins in August 2008, all balances are due June 1, 2008). Any cancellations on the customers' part will incur a cancellation fee of \$300.00 and must be made in writing. Refunds will only be given at the discretion of the BCSSA management.

Any damage to property made by your participant, your child, to the BCSSA property will be charged to you, the parent or guardian. All courses, activities, venues and travel arrangements are subject to change according to weather, programming requirements and a satisfactory level of numbers.

COURSES FOR INDIVIDUALS

As well as catering for teams, BCSSA also provide the following services for individual visitors from the UK and also from around the world.

The summer residential camp takes place at Myerscough College, Preston which is a fantastic location.

COURSE CONTENT

SOCCER

The soccer course will be comprehensive, covering all elements of the game, from basic techniques through to strategy and tactics. All participants will be expected to take an active role in this element, so it is advised that students have a good level of fitness before they attend.

Evaluations can be made in terms of the player's technical ability and BCSSA will also use the very latest high tech equipment currently being used by many Premier league teams to provide a measure of a player's physical ability.

Study of the practical elements of the game will be supported by theoretical aspects, with practical applications, such as anatomy and physiology, nutrition and psychology.

LANGUAGE - Summer School

During language lessons, besides being taught the fundamentals of English grammar and its use, lessons focus on communication and practice. BCSSA make use of the motivational powers of soccer utilizing a Worldwide language programme. This allows youngsters to study through a medium they thoroughly enjoy and in which they are both knowledgeable and confident.

Each course is centered around the needs of each pupil and the standards that are aimed for each realistic and attainable. With all elements of the programme, the early section will be used to ascertain existing levels of performance and from that an individualized learning programme will be arranged.

All aspects of the programme will be delivered in truly international classes with many opportunities to mix and converse with British youngsters, on the football pitch and more informally in a social environment.

ACCOMMODATION

MYERSCOUGH COLLEGE

For BCSSA 2008 Summer Program, BCSSA will be utilizing the superb campus of Myerscough College set in hundreds of acres of Lancashire countryside, thirty (30) minute drive from Manchester City Centre. The college has excellent facilities on site including high standard accommodation, dining and recreation rooms, excellent sports facilities including a large modern sports hall, extensive high quality playing fields, tennis courts and a nine (9) hole golf course.

BCSSA students will be accommodated in the residences on site. Rooms are twin and all have their own washbasin, with ample toilet and shower facilities on each corridor. All rooms are well furnished and carpeted. Rooms are lockable. There are comfortable and attractive common rooms.

Living on Campus:

Laundry. Personal clothing can be washed and dried using the machines available. These are coin-operated and cost £2 per wash and £2 per dry. Towels are NOT provided at the centre, so students should bring their own towels and toiletries.

Cleaning. Cleaning of communal areas and bathrooms is done daily. Bedrooms are cleaned weekly. Students will be responsible for keeping their rooms tidy. The dining room is cleaned after each meal. Bed linen is provided (and changed weekly) and beds are made up for each arrival. Thereafter, it is students' own responsibility to make their own beds each day.

BCSSA Bank. It is NOT recommended that you bring expensive electrical items and portable phones to the school. All money, passports and travel documents may be left in the BCSSA Bank which can be accessed daily.

Safety. Fire drills take place on a regular basis.

Damages. All rooms and common areas are regularly checked for damages, and individuals who cause damage to any property on the site will be liable for the cost of repairs.

Meals. Meals for all students are taken in the bright, modern refectory on site.

Breakfast is continental style but also with hot option.

Lunch is a two-course meal.

Dinner is also two courses with a choice of at least two hot dishes including a vegetarian option. A salad bar is provided and there is a dessert.

Residential

Course Start / Finish time:

5 day Residential courses run from 4.00pm Sunday to 4.00pm Friday

7 day or longer courses run from 4.00pm on Sunday to 10.00am on Sunday.

Participants should be dropped off between 2.00pm and 4.00pm on the Sunday of each week. A welcome meeting will take place at approximately 5.00pm and an evening meal will be served at 5.30pm. Participants should be collected on the finish day at 4.00pm. or if staying till Sunday at 10.00am.

Presentation:

There will be a presentation each Friday at 3.30pm, parents, friends and relatives are welcome to attend.

Evening Activities:

In the evening you will be invited to choose from a selection of fun activities which may include football tournaments, games vs local teams or overseas visitors, basketball and other sports, table tennis, and pool. However there is also a video show for those who simply wish to relax.

VALUABLES

All students are advised not to bring with them elements of personal belongings that are valuable and expensive. As a company BCSSA do not have insurance cover for personal belongings. Students are also advised to utilize the 'Bank' that BCSSA operates at all its courses; this ensures that all personal belongings are looked after. Information regarding this service will be made available on arrival.

INSURANCE

BCSSA strongly recommends the purchase of insurance coverage for travel and related travel costs, cancellation, medical, and personal property for all travelers from a broker of your choice.

TRANSFER INFORMATION

BCSSA provides a negotiated transfer service from Manchester International Airport to Myerscough College. All transfer must be pre-arranged. After collecting their luggage, students proceed through customs. Students are then met by a representative of BCSSA who will be displaying a prominent sign. From here students will be transported to their residential BCSSA centre.

It is of **vital importance** that all necessary flight details are sent to us with the booking form. BCSSA need the exact flight information, including dates, airlines, flight numbers and flight times. This service must be booked no later than four (4) weeks prior to the start of the course.

SOCCER THEME PARK

Bobby Charlton Soccer Schools recognizes the fact that young children achieve more and at an increased rate when learning in a relaxed and fun environment. It was with this in mind when BCSSA experienced BCSSA staff developed what is now known as the Soccer Theme Park.

A key balance of what a child needs to improve technically, tactically and physically whilst still having fun is the desired effect of the Soccer Theme Park. BCSSA equipment has been continually developed using ideas from coaches, managers and players resulting in the ergonomic coaching aids pictured here.

Every BCSSA course utilizes BCSSA basic Soccer Theme Park including:

Dribbling mannequins.

Passing gates.

Rebound boards.
Soccer Tennis.
Free kick wall.
Speed and agility zone.
Mini soccer arena.
Small sided goals.
Color coded different size balls.
BCSSA flags.

In addition BCSSA have developed other items for BCSSA Deluxe Soccer Theme Park including:

Laser Gun – measure speed of shot.
Heading / volley apparatus.
Giant inflatable including footy fours, shooting gallery, speed cage, ball o’ fun.

Whichever course attended, you will witness children enjoying themselves to the full, sometimes without even realizing they are learning new skills.

COURSE DETAIL

GOALKEEPERS

Dates: Summer School Myerscough

The Goalkeeper is considered to be one of the most important members of the team, but also as one of the most difficult positions to play in. Mistakes can directly lead to goals, and great saves can win matches.

BCSSA realizes that goalkeeping is a specialist position and therefore requires specialist coaching. BCSSA goalkeeper coaching staff has devised programs for all age groups with an emphasis on each individual achieving a level of success, regardless of their ability.

Topics covered on these courses include:

HANDLING	Basic set position. Body shape. Diving shape.
SHOT STOPPING	1 on 1 situation. Long distance shots. Reaction saves.
CROSS TAKING	Positioning. Organizing the defense. Technique.
DISTRIBUTION	Defense to attack. Goalkeeper as sweeper. Kicking and throwing.
COMMUNICATION	Receiving the ball. Organizing the defense. Confidence.

BCSSA will also work on set plays, concentration levels and match play.
