## General Information

These Terms and Conditions set out Manchester United Soccer Schools ('MUSS') terms and conditions specifically in relation to the operation of the soccer camp. No amendments or variations of these terms and conditions may be made except where made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of Manchester United Soccer Schools.

### 1. Sports Camp Course Content

#### Soccer Coaching Programme

Manchester United have designed and created training equipment that enhances and develops each individual to improve his or her overall game. MUSS have highly qualified and trained coaches who will ensure that a safe and challenging environment is created.

The course will also include a visit to the Theatre of Dreams, Old Trafford, the home of Manchester United where pupils will be able to tour the stadium, visit the interactive museum, and visit the Manchester United Megastore.

#### Optional Excursions

MUSS understands that overseas visitors not only want to experience Manchester United, but may have an interest in English culture. To this end excursions can be arranged to places of special interest for children, at an additional cost.

Shopping excursions to one of Europe's finest indoor malls, Manchester's exclusive Designer Outlet Mall and the fantastic Alton Towers theme park are all included dependant on your length of stay.

#### Leisure Time

All courses at MUSS are physically and mentally demanding and as such MUSS have a well-organized leisure programme. On site activities include swimming, tennis and badminton with the opportunity for students to play in small sided or 11 a side games against local opposition.

With visitors from over 25 different countries throughout the summer, the residential camps have a complete global soccer environment with English being the spoken language.

### 2. Venue

MUSS venues are self-contained sites set in English countryside with well-maintained playing fields. As well as seven (7) outdoor grass fields MUSS have floodlit astro turf, indoor facilities with on site swimming pool, tennis courts and golf course. The facilities have been chosen for their safe and secure setting.

**The 2008 MUSS Residential course will be held at two (2) venues.**

- MUSS Junior, Senior, Youth and Girls School will be held at Denstone College, Staffordshire.
- MUSS Soccer / English classes (10–16 years) will be held at Clifton College.

### 3. Staff

All MUSS people are carefully selected and undergo thorough background checks. Coaches will be of a minimum Level 2 FA Coaching Certificate qualification and have also been selected for their ability to relate to children and young adults. Coach : Player ratios are in accordance to UK laws and MUSS main aim is to offer a friendly but secure environment to learn.

With experience in hosting young people from all over the world, MUSS appreciates the different needs of different cultures. **Any special requirements must be requested prior to arrival** (e.g. Kosher meals, building for prayer)

### 4. Medical Information

All MUSS staff are trained in emergency aid within football and MUSS has number of staff trained to first aid in the workplace. There will be a full time qualified physiotherapist on site throughout the week.

The sites have a school Doctor on call with hospital access for more serious emergencies within 15 minutes.

## 5. Valuables

Students should NOT bring with them any unnecessary personal belongings that are valuable and expensive.

Students are also advised to use the on-campus bank facility offered by MUSS; this ensures that all personal belongings are secure. More information regarding this service will be made available on arrival.

## 6. General Rules for Students & Group Leaders

MUSS courses are highly structured and well disciplined. All of MUSS students are away from home and MUSS recognizes its responsibility for the students' well being whilst they are on MUSS courses. To ensure safe and well run courses there are a number of rules to adhere to:

### Rule 1

At night students have curfew times to adhere to depending on age:

8 – 14 years 22.00 hours (10pm)                      15 – 18 years 23.00 hours (11pm)

### Rule 2

Because students will be expected to take an active role in the 'Soccer' element of the programme, the use of tobacco and alcohol **will not be permitted during their stay**. It is illegal for U16's to obtain cigarettes and for U18's to drink alcohol in the UK.

Any student found using illegal substances (drugs) will be excluded from further participation in their course and will be sent home at their own expense.

### Rule 3

Facilities and activities will be provided but students will be expected to attend the course with a level of fitness and then maintain or improve that level during their course.

It is not MUSS intention to implement rigorous regulations, but compliance with the above is regarded as important to ensure the well-being and safety of all involved so that their experience with MUSS is positive. Any rules broken will result in the student being excluded from their course and will be sent home at their own expense.

## 7. Transfer Information

MUSS can provide a transfer service from Manchester International Airport and Bristol Airport (Clifton College only) to MUSS facility. All transfers **must** be pre-arranged and will carry an additional cost.

When students arrive at Manchester Airport or Bristol Airport, they should collect their luggage and proceed through customs. All students will be met by an MUSS representative, who will be wearing an MUSS uniform and displaying a prominent sign.

MUSS needs the exact flight information, including arrival date, flight number, airline, flight arrival time and departure airport.

**It is of vital importance that all necessary flight details are sent to Internet Sports Travel with the participant's reservation/application form or as soon as available.**

## 8. Terms and Conditions (Denstone College)

1. All applications must be accompanied by a deposit or payment in full of the appropriate course fee.

### **Refund policy:**

2. No refund can be given for cancellations received:

(i) for club visits, less than 4 weeks prior to the date of the relevant course; and

(ii) for residential courses, less than 6 weeks prior to the date of the relevant course.

3. For cancellations made earlier than this a full refund is available subject, in the case of residential courses, a \$150 administrative charge. Please note that a booking can be transferred to another person without charge.

4. All courses, activities, venues and travel arrangements are subject to change according to weather, programming and a satisfactory level of numbers. MUSS may cancel any courses and/or change any information given, should this be necessary for any reason. If MUSS has to cancel a course for whatever reason MUSS will offer an alternative course (if available and suitable) or a full refund.

### **Fitness:**

5. You warrant that the participant is physically fit and able to participate in the sporting activities and accordingly you accept all risks resulting from participation in the course.

6. MUSS may require additional information depending on the medical information supplied to us by you before MUSS can accept your booking.

7. In the event that the participant needs medical attention during any course then you agree to MUSS arranging for any appropriate and necessary treatment.

### **Liability:**

8. MUSS does not accept responsibility for any death, personal injury or loss of or damage to property save to the extent that it results from MUSS negligence. MUSS recommends you take out travel and personal possessions insurance for MUSS residential courses.

9. The cost of any damage caused by you or any participant you have booked on the course to any property or facilities will be passed on to you.

### **General:**
